

Sayyid Al-Hakeem: Freedom is One of the Most Important Achievements Post-2003



The Iraqi Journalists Syndicate in Karbala played a significant role during Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem's visit to the province, where H.E. met with several journalists.
