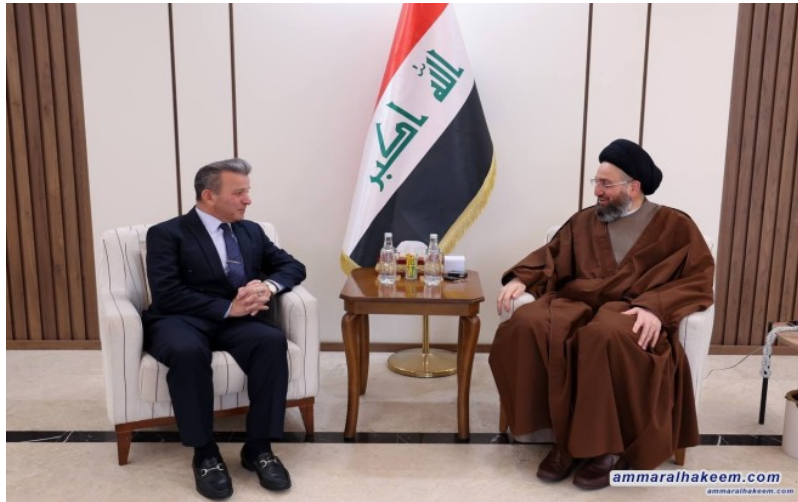


Sayyid Al-Hakeem Meets Australia's Chaldean League President, Highlights Christian Community's Role to Enrich Iraqi Society
