

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Urges Responsible Electoral Competition, to Promote Al-Hikma National Movement's Moderation in Advisory Board Meeting



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of Al-Hikma National Movement, chaired the periodic meeting of the Movement's Advisory Board, commending the tireless efforts that ensured the success of the Hussein season, the Arbreen pilgrimage, and the commemoration of the passing of Prophet Mohammed (peace be upon him and his family).
