Al-Hakeem from Al-Najaf Al-AShraf Calls to Empower Moderation Powers, Preserve Achievements Earned Through Sacrifice



From the holy city of Najaf, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers Alliance, recalled the city's rich history as the home of prophets and saints and the cradle of the revered seminary and blessed Religious Authority.
