

dSayyid Al-Hakeem Receives Phone Call From Egyptian Foreign Minister, Discusses Bilateral Relations, Regional Developments



His Eminence Sayyid Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, received a phone call from His Excellency the Egyptian Minister of Foreign Affairs, Dr. Badr Abdelatty, during which Iraqi–Egyptian relations were discussed, alongside key regional and international developments.
