

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Affirms Project's Legacy Preservation, Boast Symbols, History



As part of his visit to the Holy Najaf Governorate, His Eminence Sayyid Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, met with a large gathering of the organizational leadership of Al-Hikma National Movement in the Governorate, extending his blessings on the auspicious Eid Al-Ghadeer – the greatest Eid of Allah, the day of the completion of the religion, the perfection of divine grace, and the Lord's acceptance of Islam as our religion through the Wilaya of the Commander of the Faithful, Ali (PBUH).
