

While Presiding Over the Central Council Meeting, Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim: Only National Unity Would Prevent Foreign Intervention



Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim, head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, stressed the importance of national cohesion among the Iraqi people, as it is the dam which prevents foreign interventions, noting that foreign interference is inversely proportional to national cohesion.
