

Receiving the U.N. Representative, Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim Praises the International Organization's Understanding of the Situation in Iraq



Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim, head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, praised how the United Nations understand the situation in Iraq and expressed his hope that this would lead to additional assistance to the displaced families and their return to their regions as well as the support to Iraq in its war against terrorism.
