

Sayyid Ammar al- Hakim stresses the unity of Iraq's Land and People



Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim, head of the Islamic supreme council of Iraq, focused on the unity of Iraq by considering once again the unity of Iraq as an unoptional and compulsory fate, and that without Iraq's unity all its people will suffer.
