

Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim: the Four-Party Alliance is a Right Step, and the World's Countries must Fight ISIS

Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim, Head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, considered the quadruple alliance between Iraq, Syria, Iran, and Russia as a right step, calling on the world to fight ISIS before it's too late and have to fight it in their own countries.
