

Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim Stresses the Importance of Ramadi City Repossession and Praises the Military Progress



Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim, head of the Islamic Supreme council of Iraq, reiterated the importance of taking back Ramadi city, praising the military progress in it, its encirclement, and the liberation of some of its neighborhoods.
