

Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim Discusses with Babir Security and Economic Situations in Iraq and the Region

Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim, head of Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, stressed the complementarity of roles among political forces in Iraq, noting that what binds the federal government to the provincial government cannot be economically omitted. He added: "we are talking about a country and a largely interrelated society that its members have common interests that cannot be omitted at all", recalling that security threat has showed that the unity among Iraqis is a destiny and not a choice for any of the components. Al-Hakim also cited ISIS threat to all in the region, western regions, the center, and south, and its infringement of everyone sanctity.
