

Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakim Expresses Concern Regarding Bahraini Government's Decision To Subject Hawzas To Its Authority And Direction, And Supports Ulemas' Position That Rejects This Decision.

The head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim expressed concern regarding the consequences of Bahrain's decision to subject Hawzas to Bahraini authority and direction, stressing his support for the position of distinguished ulemas in rejecting Bahraini government's decision.
