

Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakim discusses with United Nations' special envoy Mr. Yan Kobish the role of United Nations in addressing displaced families in Iraq and reconstruction of liberated Iraqi areas



His eminence renewed his condemnations to Al-Muqdadiya incidents, expressing his admonition to take advantage of current events for political benefits and for giving priority to insular interests over the commonweal which afflicted all, indicating that Muqdadiya bombings was condemned by all sides and the Supreme Islamic Council in Iraq (SICI) was the first to respond to this attitude.
