His eminence and Baker discussed developments in the political and security situation in Iraq and the region and topics related to the international effort in support of Iraq to complete the liberation of the right bank of the city of Mosul, the last part of the city center that is under Daesh control. His eminence stressed the importance of continuing to support Iraq to get rid of global threat of Daesh, calling for international and regional effort to face Daesh intellectually.
