The National Iraqi Alliance delegation headed by Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim called the Iraqi Mandaean immigrants who were forced to leave Iraq due to the circumstances to return and contribute to the construction of Iraq with their brothers from the remaining components of Iraqi society in a meeting with Mandaean representatives Wednesday 24/5/2017.
