

Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim receives an Iranian media delegation to discuss media requirements in the coming phase

His eminence with the delegation discussed the challenges of the next phase and media discourse that should be provided, called to deliver active media instead of only transmitting media in order to be an actor in the political decision-making.

Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim warned against exploitation of media as a means of psychological warfare, pointed out that the time of Daesh that was able through media campaigns to take entire cities because of rumors and fabricated reports, stressed on starting sections and divisions in every media institution that would be tasked of encountering fake news and educate the public.

In regards of Iraq, Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim, stated that terrorist Daesh was a challenge of existence and a difficult experience that Iraqis went through with the support of a number of sides, primarily by the Islamic Republic of Iran, but Iraq is more immune to terrorism today than any other country, because terrorism has lost its bastions, and he stressed that Iraq needs messages of reassurance and resilience to pass the current phase, counted the national settlement an approach in which it had read the challenges of the phase along with solution programs and plans to complement the military conclusion.
