

Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim: Iraq is not to be ruled by iron and fire, the national majority is the solution to all the crises of Iraq

The head of the National Iraqi Alliance, Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim, in his office in Baghdad, met a delegation from the tribes of Babil province Sunday, 17/9/2017.
