Here below is the text of the statement:

Surely We Belong to Allah and to Him Shall We Return

We have received with great sorrow the death of Grand Ayatollah, Sayyid Muhammad Baqer Shirazi, son of the late great marja, Sayyid Abdullah Shirazi (May Allah sanctify their souls). The late was the older son of his father and his mate in his famous Jihadi attitudes against the vanished regime of the Shah and the Baathist regime of Aflaq.

The late Sayyid received his first religious studies at the Najaf Hawza where he grew up and attended the superior courses delivered by prominent teachers and faqihs like his father, Imam Sayyid al-Khoei, Sayyid Jamaleddin Kalbaykani and Sayyid Mahmoud Shahroudi (May Allah have mercy on them).
