

Al-Hakeem arrives to Mosul, and al-Nujaifi praises his Eminence's national role in following up the issues of citizens Iraq wide



On early Sunday morning 12th of February 2012, Sayeed Amar al-Hakeem, the head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, arrived to Mosul province (north of Iraq) as he was welcomed by Ethel al-Nujaifi, the Province governor along with some of the security leaders, sheikhs and elders.
