Al-Hakeem: Halabja will remain the guide of the country and the conscience of the nation

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On Friday 16th of March 2012, Sayeed Amar al-Hakeem, the head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq stressed – in his speech - that the martyred Halabja is a true prove of what tyrants and oppressors do not have survival forever.

This event took place at the ceremony held to mark the 24th city of Sulaimaniya of the memory of Halabja crime, as he added " the martyrs are making their mark in their tears and quiet when they surrounded those torturers and those murderers and today remind us again that they died and were killed in order to keep Iraq and the people of Iraq and the people of Kurdistan alive and advanced forward, adding Eminence that "Halabja will candle the nation and the conscience of the citizen" and that Halabja is the station was felt by the tyrants they pygmies because they stayed their venom and hatred and hate not to the people of Halabja alone but for all Iraqis when he did this heinous crime, adding Eminence that the blood of the mountains mingled with the blood of the marshes to create an epic large, such as those found today in the cohesion of all Iraqis in the face of terrorism.

Halabja, the Red Line

The head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq considered the Halabja is a red line between those who believe in the new Iraq and the change in it, and those who climb on the new Iraq and calling for their faith to change, considering that the summit meeting of the martyrs are not allowed to tyrants and oppressors on the experience of the Iraqis and their project new, stressing the need to preserve the integrity of this process and the constitutional basis sober and solid, built by the Iraqis as collateral essential in building the nation. His Eminence referred that the martyrs would hunt down the tyrants and oppressors, generation after generation and will remain a stain on black history forever.

Sayeed Amar al-Hakeem declared that his visit to Sulaimaniya and his participate in the ceremony held to mourn the victims of the massacre of Halabja came as an expression of love and

affection and common destiny that brings Iraqis in the long history and will remain united in the coming days, adding Eminence, "I come from the south and Baghdad, the capital dear to our hearts I carry with me all coffins of your sons mass graves, which mingled with the coffins of our children in those graves that pervaded the South. "

His Eminence said that the massacre of Halabja and the combined spring a clear message of resolve in to turn the pain of the Iraqis and the ordeals and their blood and their bodies to the determination and the will for life and for the building, indicating Eminence that Halabja, the martyr is the title great for the people refused to die and decided life for himself.
