

Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim with the Japanese ambassador to discuss bilateral relations between Iraq and Japan and the post-Daesh phase



Head of the National Iraqi Alliance, Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim, in his office in Baghdad received the Japanese Ambassador Mr. Fumio Iwai Sunday 9/10/2017.

His eminence with Iwai discussed bilateral relations between Iraq and Japan and ways to benefit from Japanese experiences in reconstruction of liberated cities and cities of liberators, stressed the importance of Japanese experience to countries that emerged from wars and internal conflicts, noted that Daesh is taking its last breath, but the terrorist threat needs more effort in terms of confronting, curtailing and eliminating it.
