

Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim calls on the King of Bahrain to suspend and reconsider the judgment against Sheikh al-Salman for its negative impact on the civil peace in Bahrain



Head of the Al-Hikma National Movement, Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim, called upon the King Hamad bin Isa Al-Khalifa to directly intervene to stop and review the sentencing of life imprisonment against Sheikh Ali al-Salman, Secretary-General of the Al-Wafaq Movement. And expressed regret for the verdict, indicated that the verdict has negative impact on the civil peace in Bahrain.

His eminence stressed the importance of respecting the freedom of opinion and laying the foundations for constructive criticism and opening the way for peaceful opposition, called on the countries of the world, especially Arab and Islamic countries, to support the powers of moderation against the powers of extremism, which represent a natural alternative to moderation.
