

Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim stresses on equal representation of components in the state apparatus



Head of the Reform and Reconstruction Alliance, Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim, in his office in Baghdad, received the head of the Sabeen Mandaean community, Mr. Star Jabbar Helou accompanied by deputy of the Yezidi religious authority, Mr. Hadi Baba Sheikh, and father Fa'iz Jarjis, the pastor of the church of Anglican community Wednesday 13/3/2019
