

Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem: electoral participation is moderate approach's triumph, fortifies Iraq



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, head of the National State Powers Alliance, affirmed that electoral participation is a triumph for the approach of moderation and fortifies Iraq from dangerous outcomes and that broad participation is enough to bring about qualitative change.
