

Sayyid Al-Hakeem describes narcotics “a silent terrorism”, calls to look into abuse & dealing



Sayyid Al-Hakeem, head of the National State Powers Alliance, called to considerably look into the statistics announced by the Ministry of Interior over arresting drug abusers and dealers.
