

Sayyid Al-Hakeem discusses political scene developments, bilateral ties with Australian ambassador



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, head of the National State Powers Alliance, received Her Excellency the Australian Ambassador, Paula Ganly in his office, Thursday, 13 January 2022, and discussed the bilateral relations between Iraq and Australia, the developments of the political scene in Iraq, and the exchange of expertise in agriculture, industry, and fighting terrorism.

His Eminence emphasized the importance of strengthening the bilateral ties in what serves the friendly peoples and countries, and the importance of investing the history of this relationship in all fields.

Politically, His Eminence referred to the importance of the Iraqi House of Representatives to bear responsibility in legislation and observance and to grant trust to a government that can achieve the aspirations of the Iraqi people in providing jobs and services. H.E. called to put the public trust at the top before personal interest, and concede for Iraq.

His Eminence also emphasized preserving the balance in the political equation and illustrated that Al-Hikma role continues to converge the views between the political parties, and are putting lots of effort into it.
