

Sayyid Al-Hakeem: The Public's reluctant to participate in recent elections, a sign of resentment and dissatisfaction



In the guest place of Sheikh Fahim Khaza'l Kheshan and the host of Al-Barakat clan, 22/12/2022, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, head of Al-Hikma National Movement, met a group of Sheiks and dignitaries of this generous clan, praising the sacrifices of Al-Barakat in facing the dictatorship and confronting of terrorism, indicating that Iraq is still on the rise despite the challenges.
