

Sayyid Al-Hakeem: Iraq approaches sustainable stability, security



At the host of sayyids Al-Hammash in Bald Ruz, Diyala governorate on 2/3/2023, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, head of Al-Hikma National Movement, had a session with sayyids and dignitaries at the host of the dear brother Sayyid Majid Al-Hamash, and deliberated with them on public political affairs and Diyala governorate in particular, stressing that the criminal acts in Diyala were denounced and condemned by all.
