

## Sayyid Al-Hakeem urges prior period witnesses to educate future generations about its drawbacks



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of Al-Hikma National Movement, met with the associates and loved ones of Shaheed Al-Mihrab "May his soul be sanctified," of the genuine brethren on 2/12/2023.
