

Sayyid Al-Hakeem emphasizes the importance of bridging perspectives between the federal government and the regional government, calling for fair treatment of the employee sector



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of Al-Hikma National Movement, met with Mr. Bafel Talabani, the head of the Patriotic Union of Kurdistan. During the meeting, both parties discussed the political developments in Iraq and the region, highlighting the impact of these events on the Iraqi situation. Sayyid Al-Hakeem stressed the necessity of maintaining the current stability, enhancing it, and transitioning to a phase of lasting stability on all fronts.

H.E. also underscored the significance of reconciling views between the federal government and the regional government. Emphasizing the need for justice for employees everywhere and ensuring the timely payment of their salaries so they can fulfill their daily and family commitments. H.E. emphasized the importance of balancing rights and duties. H.E. also stated that adopting and accepting this equation and its outcomes is sufficient to achieve social justice nationwide, urging political parties to shoulder their responsibilities in this regard.

Regarding the situation in Gaza, Sayyid Al-Hakeem reiterated his call for a ceasefire, providing aid to displaced individuals, rebuilding the city, and repatriating its residents. H.E. warned against turning the Palestinian issue into a case of a people without land, holding the international community responsible for its silence, which he sees as an implicit endorsement of Israel's crimes and heinous acts, contrary to human values, norms, and international laws.
