

Sayyid Al-Hakeem visits the Bar Association, engineers, and Jurists Unions, calling for laws amendments related to them and the fair treatment of their members



As part of his Ramadan tours, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of Al-Hikma National Movement, visited the unions of engineers, jurists, and bar association, extending his blessings for the holy month and the approaching Eid al-Fitr. He emphasized the necessity of utilizing these blessed days for spiritual and social aspects.
