

Sayyid Al-Hakeem: The upcoming challenge is a service challenge, and we must compensate the cities of jihad and sacrifices



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of Al-Hikma National Movement, met with a distinguished gathering of the Bekhat tribe on 25/4/2024, hosted by Sheikh Abu Adel Al-Ghanami.
