

Sayyid Al-Hakeem: The region's security is tied to Iraq's security and stability, and Babylon's potential lies in being a city of construction and reconstruction



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of Al-Hikma National Movement, met with a gathering of sheiks and dignitaries from Al-Qasim district at the residence of Sheikh Qasim Abdul Mahdi Al-Areef. His Eminence underscored the importance of Babylon province and its pivotal role in Iraq's history, stating that Babylon's destiny is to become a province of urbanization and construction.
