

Sayyid Al-Hakeem: Iraq Plays Significant Role in Bridging Regional Divides



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers Alliance, met with a delegation from the Al-Sharq Center for Strategic Studies and Information.
