
Sayyid Al-Hakeem meets the British Ambassador, discusses bilateral relations.



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, head of the National State's Powers Alliance, met with His Excellency Stephen Hitchen, the British Ambassador to Iraq, to discuss the progress of bilateral relations between our two nations and explore ways to enhance them to benefit all parties and uphold the country's sovereignty.
