

Sayyid Al-Hakeem: Regional Elections' High Voter Turnout Reflects Awareness, Democracy Commitment



At Sheikh Hadi Al-Barzanji's guesthouse, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers Alliance, met with a group of sheikhs and dignitaries.
