

Sayyid Al-Hakeem: All Hopes on Internal Unity, Services Provision



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers Alliance, met with a group of sheikhs and dignitaries from the esteemed Al-Zarari tribe, led by Sheikh Yusuf Al-Zarari.
