

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Emphasizes National Census Significance to Advance Country's Development, Reconstruction



To review preparations for the general census, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, visited the Iraqi Ministry of Planning and met with Deputy Prime Minister for Economic Affairs and Minister of Planning, Dr. Mohammed Tameem.
