

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Visits Sulaymaniyah Short-Statured Individuals Association, Affirms Support for People with Disabilities Rights



As part of H.E.'s tour in Sulaymaniyah Province, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers Alliance, met with a large group of short-statured individuals during a visit to their association. His Eminence expressed delight in visiting this significant social group, emphasizing that this visit continues a tradition of decades-long engagements, fostering love and solidarity with the people of Kurdistan and Sulaymaniyah.

During the meeting, H.E. recalled the stance of H.E.'s grandfather, Imam Sayyid Muhsin Al-Hakeem (may Allah sanctify his soul), in opposing the targeting of Kurds. H.E. affirmed that these historical positions were upheld during the eras of Shaheed Al-Mihrab and Aziz Al-Iraq (may Allah sanctify their souls).
