

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Discusses Political Developments, Security Readiness with Popular Mobilization Authority Leader



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, head of the National State Powers Alliance, met with Mr. Falih Al-Fayyadh, head of the Popular Mobilization Authority, to discuss the latest political developments in Iraq and the importance of maintaining security and military readiness.
