Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim says, "If we want to be followers of al-Husain (Ú), we have to absorb everyone for the sake of building Iraq."



Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim has stressed that the message of Imam al-Hussain ($\acute{\text{U}}$) is one of forbearance, containment and the acceptance of the other party for the sake of firming the principles of virtue and goodness. He added saying, "If we want to be followers of al-Hussain ($\acute{\text{U}}$), we have to absorb everyone for the sake of building Iraq."

This came up when the head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq (ISCI) participated on Saturday, December 29, 2012, the throngs of pilgrims from the al-Najaf al-Ashraf governorate who were heading towards Holy Kerbala to revive the anniversary of the Arba`een of Imam al-Hussain (\acute{U}) .
