

Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim says, "The secret behind the strength of the Supreme Council lies in its good relationship with everyone and in its having credibility and a clear national plan."



The expanded shura (consultative committee) of the Supreme Council was held under the presidency of Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim, head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq (ISCI), at his private office in Baghdad on Monday, February 11, 2013.

During the meeting, a discussion went on of the eventualities on the Iraqi field and the ongoing events in the region. Also, a discussion was made of the programs and future plans which contribute to developing the performance of the Supreme Council's institutions in the next phase.
