Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim Calls for Constituting the Provincial Councils within a Clear Perception and with a Competent, Equal-level Team



During a meeting with the head of the National Iraqi Alliance, Ibrahim al-Jaafari, in his office in Baghdad on Wednesday, April 24, 2013, Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim, head of the Islamic Superior Council of Iraq, called for constituting the provincial councils with competent, equal-level teams that work within a clear perception, a flawless program and a deadline, saying it is necessary for the upcoming provincial councils to have adequate support from the federal government and the parliament.
