

Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim Participates in the Islamic Awakening Conference in Tahrān



Sayyid Ammar al- Hakim, head of the Islamic Superior Council of Iraq, took part in the International Conference of Scholars and Islamic Awakening held in the Iranian Capital, Tahrān, on Tuesday, April 29, 2013 with the participation of more than 700 clerics and scholars from different Islamic confessions.
