

During a Meeting with Mr. al-Jaafari, Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim Confirms his Support for all the Governors and the New Local Governments

Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim, head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, confirmed his full support for all the governors and the new local governments, stressing the importance of maintain the state of harmony, love and common work between the provincial councils with their big and small winning blocs.
