Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim stressed the need to benefit from intellectuals and skilled citizens to solve many of the problems that Iraq is currently facing, explaining that engaging these categories in the country's development is the right step to achieve success and sustainability.

This came during a meeting held by the Head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim, in his office in Baghdad, with a group of Iraqi intellectuals and elites, on Saturday, 28/9/2013.
