During the 8th Conference of Husayni Parades, Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim Stresses the Importance of Introducing People to the Principles of the Imam's Revolution

Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim, head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, stressed the importance of introducing the people to the principles of Imam Hussein's revolution, explaining that the parades held in honor of Hussein (AS) are one of the most important arms of the Husseini slogans.
