

During the 4th Night of Muharram, Sayyid Ammar al-Hakim: Trust in Allah Does not Mean a Lack of Planning and Strategic Vision



The Head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim, stressed the importance of prior planning and strategic vision, explaining that trusting in Allah does not eliminate the need to plan and adding that the heart, the hearing and the vision are tools of insight that Allah the Almighty had put in humans and Jinns.
