

Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim Receives Iranian Under-Secretary of Foreign Affairs



The Head of the Islamic Supreme Council of Iraq, Sayyid Ammar Al Hakim, discussed the bilateral relations between Iraq and the Islamic Republic of Iran, as well as the developments in the region.
